

## HOW TO PARTICIPATE AT HUNTERDON COUNTY YMCA AS A NON-MEMBER

Several Hunterdon County YMCA programs are now available to non-members. (our software system calls non-members Guests)

Registered non-members can also register for classes online.

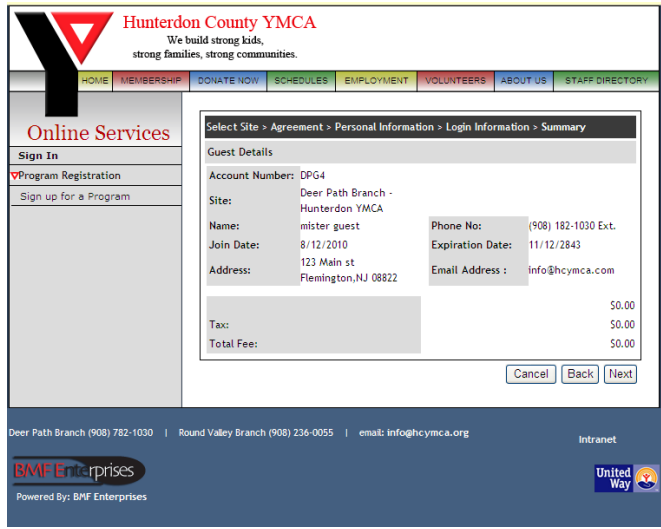
When done, click Next.
